

NEWPORT. Situated on the Ohio and Licking rivers, in Campbell county, 12 miles north of Alexandria, the county seat, directly opposite Cincinnati, Ohio, on the L. & C. short line L. & N. R. R.; was established 1795, and incorporated as a city 1849. A wire suspension bridge connects the city with Cincinnati, and another bridge spans the Licking, thus, also, connecting it with Covington. It has an assessed valuation of \$7,000,000, with a bonded debt of \$1,027,000. It possesses many fine buildings, 18 churches, representing the several denominations of Baptist, Christian, Congregational, Lutheran, Methodist, Episcopal, Catholic and United Brethren, 3 public and a high school, maintaining 46 teachers, and having an enrollment of 2,825 scholars. A good library is also here. Street cars traverse its principal streets, which are wide and handsome, and lighted by gas, supplied from Covington. Among its business enterprises may be mentioned 2 banks, with an aggregate capital of \$300,000, 2 newspapers, an establishment engaged in manufacturing watch-cases, a bolt and nut works, 2 rolling mills, a tanners' tool manufactory, a distillery, an agricultural implement factory, and 2 breweries. The *Kentucky State Journal* is issued tri-weekly and weekly. The Newport U. S. barracks, the headquarters of the Military Department of the South, are located here.
