An ACT concerning the town of WASHINGTON, in Majon county, and for other purpofes.

(PASSED FEBRUARY 87th, 1797.)

Truffes of Waftingles empowered to trey consulty a certoen fum to repair the frecis, &c.

§ 1. BE it enatied by the general affembly. That the trustees of the town of Walhington, in the county of Mason, and their succesfors in office, are hereby empowered to levy on the real property within the bounds of faid town, any fum not exceeding one hundred pounds per annum, for the purpose of levelling and keeping in repair the streets and alleys, and building a market-house in said town; which sums so levied shall be collected and accounted for in the following manner: The trustees, or a majority of them, shall annually in the month of March appoint three fit persons, either of their own body or others being inhabitants and freeholders in faid town, who shall value in current money the real estates therein, which valuation shall be returned to the said truftees, who shall affess and apportion to each person the sum to he paid by each in proportion to fuch valuation, and the remaining truftees shall value and apportion in like manner the real estates of tuch persons to appointed. The trustees, or a majority of them, shall have power and authority to appoint annually a collector for the purpose of collecting such sum or sums of money as may be affeffed, taking from such collector bond with such fecurity as they shall approve, with penalty in double the sum to be collected, payable to the faid truffees and their successors in office, and with a condition for the faithful execution of his office: and the faid collector shall have the same powers to collect, have the same allowance for collecting, and be liable to be proceeded against by the said trustees and their successors in the same manner for fuch money as he shall or ought to collect and does not pay, as theriffs are entitled and tubjected to, with respect to county levies. And be it further enacted, That the faid truftees shall, in the month of November or December in every year, lay before the county court of the faid county, a fair statement of the receipts and disbursements of the money by them received in compliance with this act, and shall transmit the residue in their hands to their Penalty for fair successors in office: and in case of default may be proceeded

And be it further enasted, That whosoever shall be guilty of running or racing horses in the streets or highways, or shooting of Mayfrille or Men- at marks within the limits of the in-lots of the town of Mayfville, in the county of Mason, or of the town of Stanford, in the county of Lincoln, shall forfeit and pay for every such offence, the sum of fix shillings; which forfeitures shall be collected in the name of the truftees of faid town, and be recovered in the manner fums of like amount are recoverable by law, and shall be applied by the faid truftees for keeping the bridges and streets of the said towns in repair.
